

# Vice Commodore's Report


Spring is in the air, snow is gone and ice is melting. It won't be long till we start getting our boats in order.

It was nice to see those who attended the membership appreciation on March 22, 2015.



I have attended the I-LYA Spring Meeting and Banquet held on March 27 - 29 and will have information from that meeting in our May Log.


Unfortunately the steak roast fundraiser which was scheduled for April 25 has been postponed.
