Poker Runs

1

What are they?

A poker run is an AYC event. Every AYC affiliated club has a poker run approximately every 4-5 years. The poker run is held in conjunction with the club's regatta. Which means it is like a regatta on steroids. Usually twice the amount of people and boats and most clubs have live music etc. A bigger party.

They hold 5 poker runs a year at different clubs. This year they are being held at Toledo Sail Club 6-19 to 6-21, Swan Boat Club 7-3 to 7-5, Maumee River Boat Club 7-31 to 8-2, Bayview Yacht Club 8-21 to 8-23, and Detroit Beach Boat Club 9-11 to 9-13.

Who can go?

Any club that is affiliated with AYC can attend. This means that any member of SPBC can attend. To attend all you have to do is register for the event and show up.

How do they work?

The Fleet Captain of the club is an AYC delegate which means they attend the AYC meetings, stay current with AYC events going on in other clubs, and take care of the mileage boat for the poker runs. The club receives mileage credits for each boat that attend a poker run. At the last poker run you have opening of the cards, where they tally up the mileage from each club. The most mileage wins. So, if you attend a poker run by boat make sure you register with the fleet captain or whoever has the mileage book.

Why Should I Attend?

If you want to go to different marinas, meet new people, have fun and most of all use your boat, you should attend the poker runs. If you attend all 5 you receive a flag you can fly to show off you attended all of them. Also, at each location you get a card and at the end of the season, at the opening of the cards, the person holding the best hand wins a substantial sum of cash.

Join us at the first poker run of the year for a truly remarkable experience!
