








Ahoy Fellow Boaters,



It is a little tricky to navigate the design process the 1st time. I used the call in phone number for assistance. I ordered 2 sweatshirts, 1 ladies and 1 mans. I also utilized the Promotique site for the womens shirt. You can navigate there using the tabs on the top left side of the website. There are 3 tabs VistaPrint, Promotique, & Digital Design.

The prices were reasonable, obviously the more that is ordered at the same time the better the price is. Both sweatshirts were about \$55.00 out the door with taxes and shipping. They will be shipped to our address and are prepaid at check out with your personal credit card. Approx 3 weeks for delivery. I have attached pictures below of what I ordered.
