

Looking forward to seeing everyone soon.





A few weeks ago, a powerboat (one of our members) got tied up in the start sequence of Monday night sailboat races. So what happens is there are up to 20 boats involved. There are 2 or 3 starts that are spaced 5 minutes apart. Flags are flown off the red committee boat that lets racers know when there race starts. It can get extremely hectic and this is definitely the most dangerous part of it. There are a lot of right away rules that powerboats simply don't have. End of the day, I just don't want to see anyone get hurt or any damage to any boats. If you see a pile of sailboats all piled up and a red steel boat with them, please try to avoid the area until the race is underway. Most but not all races start between the southern tip of Grassy and Fighting. Kind of straight across from Riverview Marina but in the other channel.


