The prices were reasonable, obviously the more that is ordered at the same time the better the price is. Both sweatshirts were about \$55.00 out the door with taxes and shipping. Sunday, , 2021

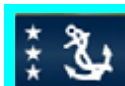

6. The First Mate should hold the National Flag from fluttering.
7. Please stow all drinks during passing.
8. This is a solemn and fun day, please do it safely and graciously.
9. Free dockage available at your docking time.

A lunch will be available for a nominal fee back at Holiday Harbour.

When registering, please have boat name and size, registration number, Captain and First mate name. Number on board and if you will be docking for lunch.
