Rules

Basics:

Each person gets five cards and the best poker hand wins the pot at the end of the evening. Just like a "poker run" you get a card with each game you play (total 3), the last 2 you buy (\$2.00).

For darts, high score of 3 darts wins the round.

For LEFT-RIGHT-CENTRE normal rules apply.

Cards:

You will choose one card at the door as you enter. Do not look at it. Place it into a card slot on the Player's Board and take a number from that slot. Each time you get a card, place it into your slot (as shown by the number you took).

If you play the Dart Game you will be given a card at the start of each game (max. 2 cards)

If you play the Left-Right-Centre Game you will be given a card at the start of each game (max.2)

The total number of free cards can not exceed 3.

The last 2 cards can be obtained by a donation of \$1.00 each

Each time you get a card, do not look at it. Put it into the card slot associated with your number.

The player with the best poker hand will win 1/2 of the proceeds from all games.

In the event of a draw, each player will draw 5 cards from the pile until a winner is determined.

Darts:

Pick up one card and put it into your card slot.

For a \$2.00 donation you will get 3 darts.

Your score will be the total of the three darts thrown from designated area.

Woman's distance 7'9", men's distance 10'9"

Scoring will be: bull's eye - 30

inner - 25

double and triple rings count as double and triple score

The winner of each round wins 1/2 the amount of that round's donation

The other half is split between the Card Game and the club.

Left Right Centre:

Pick one card and put it into your card slot.

For a \$2.00 donation you will receive 3 quarters to play, 1 quarter goes into that pot, \$1.00 goes into the kitty that is split between the Card Game pot and the club.

All normal game rules apply and any carry overs are handled as being the same game.

- 8) Free dockage is available




