





#### The full agenda to follow but this one notice of motion was made at the December 6, 2019 GMM and will be discussed and voted on.

Capital Account Funds: P/C Doug Potier suggested capping the Capital Account at \$15,000 and all additional funds be placed in the General Operating Account. All were in favor of moving this item to the next General Membership meeting for discussion.

The Board is requesting approval to cap the Capital Account at .1 \$15,000.

Due to externating circumstances the Board is seeking approval .2 to access dollars (borrow with the intent to pay back) in the Capital Account if required to support the Club's operating costs until September 30, 2021 to keep the Club going.
